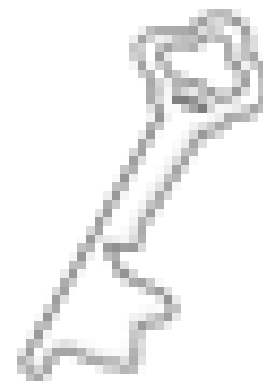


Girl Scout Volunteer Mentoring Award White Key

The Girl Scout Volunteer Mentoring Award White Key is for the mentoring volunteer. This award is presented based on a specific volunteer assignment in mentoring.

Criteria for Selection

Stage 2 (White Key)

1. A registered adult Girl Scout volunteer serving in any capacity.
2. Have gained sufficient skills and experience as a coach or mentor
3. Coaches or mentors a new volunteer resulting in their retention to continue volunteering for two years

Nomination and Approval Procedures

Submit the application describing the volunteer's accomplishments to the Council Recognitions Review Committee for approval

Form of Recognition

The GSUSA Mentoring Award White Key is a skeleton key charm that attaches to chain of Volunteer Development Award Pin. The White Key Charm denotes Girl Scout Mentoring Award. The Council purchases the pin and provides it to the Service Unit for presentation at a Service Unit Recognition Ceremony.
