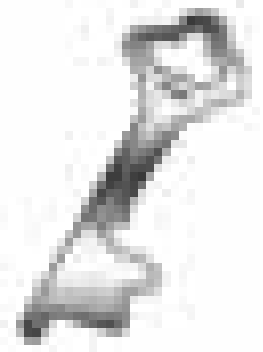


Girl Scout Community Cultivation Award Silver Key



Deadline: Submit to Council Recognition Review Committee no later than February 15th at 5:00pm

The Girl Scout Mentoring Award Silver Key is for the community cultivation volunteer. This award is presented based on a specific volunteer assignment in community cultivation.

Criteria for Selection

Stage 5 (Silver Key)

1. A registered adult Girl Scout volunteer serving in any capacity.
2. Have increased volunteer membership by utilizing the talents and skills of all the dimensions of diversity:
 - a. 18-29
 - b. episodic volunteers
 - c. males
 - d. 55 plus
3. Have increased girl membership that reflects the diversity in the council jurisdiction:
 - a. Racial/ethnic
 - b. Disability
 - c. Socio-economic
4. STUDIO 2B
 - a. Retaining 11-17 year olds
 - b. Marketing the concept to the community
5. Have established effective partnerships that help achieve the council's membership goal
 - a. Corporate partnerships
 - b. Government agencies
 - c. Foundations
 - d. all businesses
 - e. Religious institutions
 - f. Other

Submit the application describing the volunteer's accomplishments to the Council Recognitions Review Committee for approval
