Code of Conduct for Adults

For all troop, Service Unit or Council sponsored trips

I understand that my attitude and behavior are critical to the success of any Girl Scout event/trip. Therefore, for the good of the event/trip, as well as for my fellow volunteers, I agree to abide by the following:

- Remember that I represent Girl Scouts – DAOT and GSUSA; and that behavior appropriate to the Girl Scout Promise and Law is expected at all times.
- I will be sensitive to needs of each event participant by performing my assigned duties including, but not limited to kapers, clean-up, program planning, etc.
- I will respect the places and people with whom I come in contact. I will not make inappropriate remarks or gestures.
- I will be responsible for my personal belongings and equipment and will not hold the event/trip sponsor responsible for their loss or damage.
- I will use any safety equipment furnished by the event/trip sponsor for my own safety. I will observe safety precautions for all activities with the event. Such observation will include the use of the buddy system with the girls at all times, the supervision of the girls by an adult volunteer or staff at all times, and utilizing all other safety precautions that will be discussed with participants.
- I understand that the use of alcohol, tobacco, drugs (other than those prescribed for medical purposes) or foul language will not be permitted at any time during the event/trip. I also understand that the usage of these items will result in expulsion from the event/trip.
- I understand that if expelled from event/trip that I will be responsible for reimbursement for any fees that have been paid from me to attend the event/trip.
