

**Long drive? No problem!** Earn your Road Trip Patch when you travel over 120 miles\* to a Signature Event and complete eight of the 15 activities listed below!

Have fun! Let girls take the lead and decide which eight activities they would like to do. This worksheet is designed to be easy to complete regardless of whether you've spent a meeting preparing to do so or are printing it off and throwing it in your troop binder at the last minute! There's a path for everyone.

**1. Window Paint Your Car | \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)**

Show your Girl Scout pride! Use car window paint to draw a Girl Scout trefoil or write fun things like "We love Girl Scouts!," "Scout-O-Rama bound!," "Girls <3 STEM" or "Girl Scout Ambassadors rock!"

**2. Learn How to Pump Gas | \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)**

Ask a troop leader or parent to show you how to pump gas. (Note: Children under licensed driving age should not operate the pump but may observe.)

**3. Dashboard Master | \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)**

Ask an adult riding as a passenger (or the driver while they aren't driving) to teach you about the car's odometer, speedometer, fuel gauge, dashboard indicator lights, turn signals, headlights, windshield wipers, gear shift, rearview and side mirrors.

**4. Pop the Hood | \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)**

Have you ever seen what makes a car run? Pop the hood and take a look! Ask an adult to help you identify the engine, battery, windshield wiper fluid, oil and more!

**5. Plan a Meeting, Campout or Upcoming Journey | \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)**

Road trips are a great time to plan! Use this time to plan the who, what, where, when, why and how of an upcoming campout, meeting, badge you want to earn or Journey you want to complete with your Girl Scout sisters.

**8. Geography Journey | \_\_\_\_\_ (initial)**

You might drive through the Ozark Mountains, Ouachita Mountains, Arkansas River Valley, Arkansas Delta, Gulf Coastal Plain, Piney Woods, Crowley's Ridge, Prairie Plains and more! Use a map (or pull out your phone) to see where each region is and learn about what makes different regions unique!

Bring some sticky notes and washable markers! Pick 1-2 girls (or adults) to call out random words from road signs, and write one on each sticky note, sticking them to the inside of your window. Then challenge yourself to create a complete sentence by rearranging them!

Make up a silly story with your troop or family one sentence at a time! One girl will start the story with a sentence that begins, "Once upon a time, ..." Then, the next person will make up the next sentence of the story. Go in a circle around the car making up the story one sentence at a time until the story ends with "The End!"

Print out a map of the U.S. for each person in your car and then play a fun—and educational!—game of bingo. When anyone in the car sees an out-of-state license plate, they should shout it out and then mark it on their map. If you forget the maps, make a list instead!
