

CODE OF CONDUCT FOR GIRLS

For all troop, Service Unit or Council sponsored trips

I understand that my attitude and behavior are critical to the success of any Girl Scout event. Therefore, for the good of the event, as well as for my fellow members, I agree to abide by the following:

- Remember that I represent Girl Scouts – DAOT and GSUSA; and that behavior appropriate to the Girl Scout Promise and Law is expected at all times.
- I will be sensitive to needs of each event participant by performing my assigned duties including, but not limited to kapers, clean-up, program planning, etc.
- I will respect the places and people with whom I come in contact. I will not make inappropriate remarks or gestures.
- I will be responsible for my personal belongs and equipment and will not hold the event/trip sponsor responsible for their loss or damage.
- I will use any safety equipment furnished by the event/trip sponsor for my own safety. I will observe safety precautions for all activities within the event/trip. Such observation will include staying with my buddy at all times, being supervised by an adult volunteer or staff at all times, and utilizing all other safety precautions that will be discussed with participants.
- I understand that if I am sent home early due to any serious misconduct, it will be at my parent or guardian’s expense. I also understand we will be responsible for reimbursement for any fees that were paid for me to take part in the event/trip. I also understand that this may result in my exclusion from future event/trips.

Both parent/guardian and participant must sign the Code of Conduct.
