There's a "Happy Camper" anchor with a rocker patch for each of our five properties. Got a multi-level troop? Just complete a variety of activities from the levels represented in your troop. While we do ask that you document your visit for our communications team, earning your patch is on your honor!

Daisy Level

1. Choose a Diamonds property and visit for the day
2. Learn at least one historical fact about the property you are visiting
3. Perform an age-appropriate service project to benefit the property
4. Participate in an age-appropriate camp activity (canoeing, hiking, STEAM, horseback riding)
5. Prepare a snack to take on your trip
6. Take photos of yourself (troop, family, etc) during your visit and submit a photo and a brief story about your visit to online@girlscoutsdiamonds.org for possible inclusion in Girl Scouts - Diamonds social media or publications.

Brownie Level

1. Choose a property and visit for the day
2. Learn at least two (2) historical facts about the property you are visiting
3. Perform an age-appropriate service project to benefit the property
4. Participate in two (2) age-appropriate camp activities (canoeing, hiking, archery, horseback riding, STEAM)
5. With the help of an adult, make a s'more over a campfire.
6. Take photos of yourself (troop, family, etc) during your visit and submit a photo and a brief story about your visit to online@girlscoutsdiamonds.org for possible inclusion in Girl Scouts - Diamonds social media or publications.

Junior Level

1. Choose a property and stay at least one (1) night in a site-specific building
 - Burnham Woods – Kelly Cabin
 - Cahinnio – Cabin (BA Unit) or Jeffrey House
 - Crossed Arrows – Eagle's Nest
 - NOARK – Friendship Lodge or Chalet
 - Radford House – Visitor's choice
2. Learn at least three (3) historical facts about the property you are visiting, including the facts below:
3. Perform an age-appropriate service project to benefit the property
4. Participate in one (1) age-appropriate camp activity
5. Prepare a banana boat over a campfire
6. Take photos of yourself (troop, family, etc) during your visit and submit a photo and a short article about your visit to and a brief story about your visit to online@girlscoutsdiamonds.org for possible inclusion in Girl Scouts - Diamonds social media or publications.

Cadette Level

1. Choose a property and stay at least two (2) nights in a site-specific building (The two nights do not have to be consecutive)
 - Burnham Woods – Cookie Cabin
 - Cahinnio – Platform tent
 - Crossed Arrows – Cabin (Cherokee Unit)
 - NOARK – Cabin (Daisy Patch)
 - Radford House – Visitor’s choice
2. Learn at least four (4) historical facts about the property you are visiting
3. Perform an age-appropriate service project to benefit the property
4. Participate in two (2) age-appropriate camp activities
5. Cook a meal outside using two methods (propane stove, campfire, dutch oven or box oven).
6. Take photos of yourself (troop, family, etc) during your visit and submit a photo and a short article about your visit and a brief story about your visit to online@girlscoutsdiamonds.org for possible inclusion in Girl Scouts - Diamonds social media or publications.

Senior Level

1. Choose a property and stay at least two (2) consecutive nights in a site-specific building OR stay one (1) night and assist a younger troop with their camp visit while there
 - Burnham Woods – Cookie Cabins
 - Cahinnio – Platform tent or Pitch your own tent
 - Crossed Arrows – Cabin (Osage Unit)
 - NOARK – Platform tent (Pooh Corner)
 - Radford House – Cabins
2. Learn at least five (5) historical facts about the property you are visiting
3. Perform an age-appropriate service project to benefit the property
4. Participate in two (2) age-appropriate camp activities
5. Build a box oven; prepare a dessert.
6. Take photos of yourself (troop, family, etc) during your visit and submit a photo and a brief story about your visit to online@girlscoutsdiamonds.org for possible inclusion in Girl Scouts - Diamonds social media or publications.

Ambassador Level

1. Choose a property, pitch your own tent and stay at least two (2) consecutive nights PLUS help plan and execute a Council, SU or younger troop event
2. Learn at least six (6) historical facts about the property you are visiting
3. Perform an age-appropriate service project to benefit the property
4. Participate in three (3) age-appropriate camp activities, with one being a water sport (canoeing, kayaking, sailing, ect).
5. Prepare a meal using only box oven and Dutch oven cooking.
6. Create a video of yourself (troop, family, etc) during your visit explaining why you love Girl Scouts and/or the property you visit and submit to online@girlscoutsdiamonds.org for possible inclusion in Girl Scouts - Diamonds social media or publications.

Adult Level

1. Accompany a group of Girl Scouts on a trip to/stay at a Diamonds property OR volunteer to help facilitate activities at a Council-sponsored event on the property
2. Teach a traditional camp song to the group and sing it while at the property
3. Participate in the group camp activities during visit
4. Assist group with service project and ensure the group “leaves the property better than they found it” before leaving
5. Give a brief presentation of your visit at a Service Unit meeting or to another local Girl Scout troop to encourage them to also visit the property
