

# Individually Registered Girl Scout Program Information (IRG)

2022 Fall Product Program

## **What is an Individually Registered Girl Scout (IRG)?**

An IRG, sometimes called a Juliette, is a registered Girl Scout who chooses to participate in Girl Scouting outside of the troop experience. An IRG has the same opportunity to participate in Product Programs as any other Girl Scout.

## **How does my IRG get started in the Fall Product Program?**

To get started in the Fall Product Program, you will need to connect with the area Service Unit Product Manager (SUPM). When it comes to participating in either Product Programs (Fall Product and Cookies), the SUPM manages and coordinates the program for IRGs. If you are unsure of the volunteer who holds that role in your area, contact [product@girlscotusdiamonds.org](mailto:product@girlscotusdiamonds.org). The council's Product Program Team will be happy to assist with connecting you to them.

Once you have connected with the SUPM, they will:

- train the IRG and parent on the program and provide any pertinent dates/deadlines
- provide sales materials
- be the first point of contact for any questions or concerns during the program
- be the person to submit orders to
- be the person to turn money in to
- distribute rewards at the end of the program

## **How does my IRG participate in the Fall Product Program?**

An IRG can participate in the Traditional (in-person) and Online pathways of the Fall Product Program. There are no restrictions on pathways.

## **What Incentives does my IRG receive for participating?**

An IRG that is in the Daisy, Brownie, and Junior levels will earn rewards based on the sale goals listed on the rewards card in addition to Program Credits that are loaded onto a Traditional Diamonds Dollars Card.

An IRG that is in the Cadette, Senior, and Ambassador levels can earn items on the rewards card as listed above but this age-level of Girl Scouts does have the opportunity to opt-out of receiving the prize items and receiving extra Program Credits in place of the items. If an IRG opts-out, they will receive any patches offered on the reward card and their Program Credits loaded onto a Traditional Diamonds Dollar Card.

## **What are Program Credits?**

In compliance with GSUSA's policies, all girls who are not in the troop pathway don't receive individual proceeds, however, they do receive Program Credits. Program Credits allow a girl the means to purchase items in Girl Scouts – Diamonds shops and pay for council events, Diamonds Travel Pathway, camp registration fees, and her membership fees. Program Credits are awarded on a sliding scale (please see page 2). All Program Credits earned by an IRG are loaded onto a Traditional Diamonds Dollars Card (this is in addition to any earned Diamonds Dollars). Parents/girls will use that card number to apply credits to the above listed items.
