



## Juliette Low Seminar 2022 Dec 2 -11, 2022

Girls Scouts of the USA is looking for representatives to attend this year's Juliette Low Seminar (JLS). Each triennium, the World Association of Girl Guides & Girl Scouts (WAGGGS) hosts this Seminar to build friendships across borders and help young women step outside of their comfort zones. This event is all about empowering participants with the leadership practices and mindsets they need to succeed. Join us to meet your Girl Guiding and Girl Scouting peers in a unique environment, explore how to actively tackle gender barriers to leadership, and bring about positive change for girls in your community when you return.

The JLS 2022 will empower up to 500 young women (aged 18 to 30) around the world with the leadership practices, global perspectives, and a peer support network to take the lead in their lives and act on their values to bring positive social change to their world. This year's theme for the 2022 JLS is: **#Lead4Impact**

### Participants must be:

- An active member of GSUSA
- A member of the Global Leadership Opportunities (GLO pool). If you are not currently a member of the GLO pool, please complete this [application and council endorsement](#) and submit with your Juliette Low Seminar application.
- Age 18-30 by October 11, 2022
- Able to understand and communicate well in one of the following: Arabic, English, French, Mandarin (Chinese), Spanish or Swahili
- Adaptable, culturally sensitive, and open minded
- Willing to undertake new and challenging experiences
- Mature and responsible global citizen
- Available online: 2<sup>nd</sup> – December 11, 2022
- Good internet connection

### Event details:

- This event will be virtual
- The JLS will launch on International Day of the Girl on the 11th of October 2022
- There will be an online learning phase of the program taken at participants own pace following the launch and continuing through November 2022
- The JLS event dates are the 2nd to the 11th of December 2022
  - From the **Friday the 2nd to Sunday the 4th** and **Saturday the 10th and Sunday the 11th of December** participants will be expected to be online from either 9am to 2.30pm UTC or 1pm to 6.30pm UTC.
  - From **Monday the 5th to Friday the 9th of December** there will be some flexible learning experiences including patrol meetings where times will be negotiated with participants.
- Members who have previously attended a WAGGGS seminar or CSW event will not be considered.
- Applicants must apply and be accepted by GSUSA before being considered by WAGGGS.
- After the seminar, participants are expected to work with their association to empower at least 100 younger Girl Scouts with leadership practices when they return home.
